This year's BOOS Annual meeting will be held in 12-13 June, from 9am-17pm for both days. The meeting will be hosted by IOW in Rostock, Germany. The meeting will include one-day scientific workshop, half-day for BOOS project progress report and member progress report, and half-day business meeting.

One-day scientific workshop: it will cover different topics in related to monitoring, modelling, forecasting and service products, not only for operational oceanography but also for climate change adaptation and ecosystem based management. Contribution on emerging research, e.g., Baltic Earth system, seamless monitoring, modelling and service capacity development, ocean observing integration between operational, environmental and research communities and using machine learning & deep learning in operational oceanography are also encouraged.

Half-day progress report:
